All 6 & 8 person classes are awarded 3 trophies

- MEN - \$40.00 fee (any male who pitches 40 ft regardless of age)
- ELDER MEN - \$40.00 fee (any male pitching short distance – eligible the year of their 70th birthday)
- WOMEN - \$40.00 fee (any women regardless of age)
- JUNIOR BOY – no fee (eligible through the year of their 18th birthday)
- JUNIOR GIRL – no fee (eligible through the year of their 18th birthday)
- CADET – no fee (eligible through the year of their 12th birthday) pitches at 20ft

To be eligible to play, a player must be a bona fide resident of Minnesota and a member in good standing with the MGSHPA and NHPA. Any person residing full time in the state at least 90 days prior to the State Tournament shall be considered a bona fide resident. To qualify for the State Tournament, adult pitchers (except Special Needs pitchers) must have an established Natstats average. This is different from past years, to allow more to be able to participate with recent Covid-19 limitations. All qualifying events must be pitched from the pitching distance of the division entered. Junior and Special Needs pitchers who do not have a tournament or league average must submit with their entry, results of pitching 100 shoes using two shoes and walking back and forth. The results needs to be signed by a MGSHPA member who observed the qualifying pitching.
