Tournament Reminders

- Dress Code (from NHPA Rule 12 C and MGSHPA bylaws):
All pitchers must have their name and city location printed in at least two-inch letters on the back of their shirt during competition.
No sleeveless shirts.
No cut-offs.
Closed-toed shoes are required.
- Drop Out (from MGSHPA bylaws)
Any player who enters the state tournament and drops out before the event is completed is automatically barred from future state tournaments for one year unless the player left the tournament due to sickness or other causes beyond their control that have been verified by the tournament director.
- Conduct on the Courts (from NHPA Rule 12 A):
No disturbing noises or movements that would distract the opponent or contestants on adjacent courts.
No other inappropriate behavior such as profanity, abusive language, obscene gestures, etc.
- Sportsmanship (from NHPA Rule 12 B):
Each member is responsible for maintaining conduct fitting for public attention.
Unsportsmanlike conduct may be subject to expulsion from the tournament. No heckling or unfair rooting, no use of profanity or abusive language, no obscene gestures, etc.
- Alcohol, Tobacco, Controlled Substances (from NHPA Rule 12 D)
The use of alcohol, any form of tobacco, or illegal controlled substances while in the confines of the courts is prohibited for all contestants, officials, and scorekeepers.
- Cell Phones (from NHPA Rule 12 E)
The use of cell phones is not allowed by anyone on the courts.
